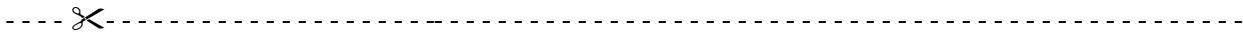
SECOND CALL FOR PAPERS
