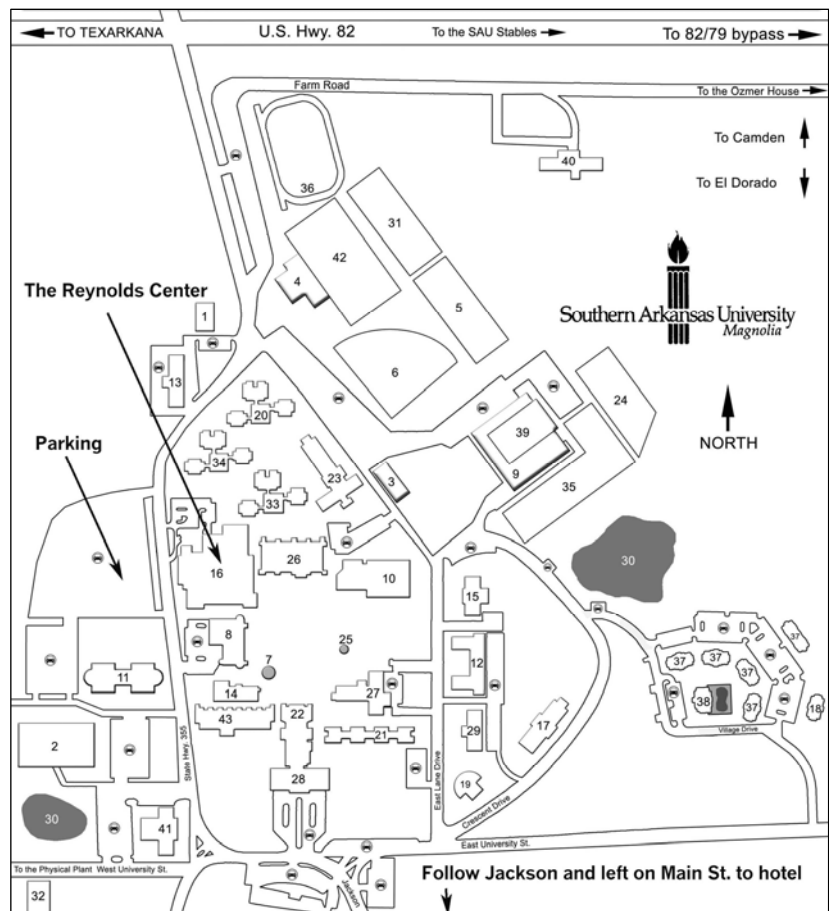
The registration fee for the conference is \$25 dollars at the door (reduced to \$15.00 for students with ID).
