### **Two Muleriders Named to All-Tournament Team**

Magnolia, Ark. - Kolby Tucker and Cody Jones of Southern Arkansas University, the Gulf South Conference champion, have been selected to the 2006 NCAA Division II South Central Region All-Tournament Team.

Tucker is a senior outfielder from Joplin, Mo., and Jones is a sophomore pitcher from Springhill, La.

The University of Montevallo, the tournament champion, dominated the All-Tournament Team. Montevallo, which was eliminated from the Gulf South Conference Tournament in three games, placed first baseman Daniel Tankersley, second baseman Dave Nanney, third baseman Travis Fultz, designated hitter Dustin Walls, outfielders Brantley Clay and Daniel Furuto, and pitcher Rudy Mask on the team. Furuto was chosen the tourney's Most Valuable Player.

Tourney runner-up University of the Incarnate Word was represented by catcher Chris Solis, shortstop Matt Seale, and pitcher Blake Weston. The other three tournament teams, the University of West Alabama, host Abilene Christian University, and the University of Central Oklahoma failed to place anyone on the All-Tournament Team.

Tucker hit .615 (8-13) for the tournament, scoring four runs and driving in three. He drew one walk, stole one base, had a sacrifice fly, and was errorless in eight chances in the outfield.

Jones had only one appearance in the tournament, getting a complete game 4-3 victory in the opening round over Central Oklahoma. He allowed nine hits, walked one and struck out 10.
