### **ATU, OBU First, SAU 11<sup>th</sup> In Golf Tourney**

Russellville, Ark. --- Host Arkansas Tech University and Ouachita Baptist University tied for first with scores of 292 after the first round of a golf tournament held at Chamberlyne Country Club in Danville Monday. The University of Central Arkansas was a close third with 294.

Washburn University of Kansas was fourth with 298, Rockhurst University of Missouri fifth with 303, Delta State University and Southwestern Oklahoma State University tied for sixth with 307, Henderson State University and Central Missouri State University tied for eighth with 309, the Arkansas Tech "B" team was 10<sup>th</sup> with 314, Southern Arkansas University was 11<sup>th</sup> with 316, Harding University 12<sup>th</sup> with 320, the University of Arkansas-Monticello 13<sup>th</sup> with 339 and Lyon College 14<sup>th</sup> with 371.

Nick Quast of ATU led the individual field with scores of 34-36 for a 70 with Blake McAfee of HSU and Daniel Haughian of UCA tied for second with 71's. Justin Bates of OBU and Joe Pryor of CMSU tied for fourth with 72's.

SAU individual scores were Adam Hamilton 36-41 for 77, Jordan Estes 45-34 for 79, Chris Wasson 38-41 for 79, Leonard Biddle 41-40 for 81 and Lance Lester 42-42 for 84.
