ATU Upsets DSU, SAU Ninth

Cabot, Ark. --- Arkansas Tech University upset front-runner Delta State University for the championship of the University of Central Arkansas Collegiate Tournament at the Cypress Creek course at Greystone Country Club here Tuesday. ATU was first with a three-round score of 869 with DSU runner-up with 875. Host UCA was third with 888.

Henderson State University was fourth with 905, Ouachita Baptist University fifth with 906, the UCA "B" Team was sixth with 911, Christian Brothers University seventh with 950, Harding University eighth with 956, Southern Arkansas University ninth with 961, and Hendrix College 10th with 991. Lyon College, Central Baptist College, and the University of Arkansas-Monticello also competed but failed to qualify.

Individually, Clark Richardson of Delta State shot a three-round total of 206 to win first place honors over runner-up Nick Quast of Arkansas Tech, who shot a 210. Windy conditions hampered the golfers.

For Southern Arkansas, Leonard Biddle shot a three-round total of 235 with Lance Lester second with 238, Mike Thomason was third with 246, and Chris Wasson fourth with 248.
