Delta State Wins Ouachita Invitational

Arkadelphia, Ark. --- Delta State University shot a 10 under par to win the Ouachita Baptist University Invitational Golf Tournament here Tuesday at DeGray State Park Golf Course. DSU shot a 566 with host Ouachita Baptist second with a one over par 577. Henderson State University was third with 581 and Arkansas Tech University fourth with a seven over par 583.

The rest of the field included the University of Central Arkansas at 594, Texas A&M University-Commerce 596, the Arkansas Tech "B" team 608, Harding University 613, Drury College (Mo.) 616, Ouachita Baptist "B" team 622, Southern Arkansas University 655 and the University of Arkansas-Monticello 765.

Individually, Brent Wilson of Arkansas Tech and Kevin Jones of Delta State led the field with six under par 138 with Wilson shooting 69 Monday and 69 Tuesday, and Jones shooting 67 Monday and 71 Tuesday. Kenny Le Sager and Clark Richardson, both of Delta State, tied for third with 140's.

For SAU, Chris Wasson shot 157 (81-76), Lance Lester 158 (81-77), Bryan LaRue 163 (84-79), and Greg Griffin 177 (87-90).
