UCA, DSU Lead in ATU Classic

Russellville, Ark. - The University of Central Arkansas and Delta State University shared the lead after the first round of the Arkansas Tech University Collegiate Golf Classic Monday. The match is being held at Chamberlyne Country Club in Danville.

Central Arkansas and Delta State had rounds of 296 to tie for the lead. Host Arkansas Tech is only a stroke back with a third place 297, and Central Missouri State University is in contention in fourth place with 299.

Rounding out the field are Ouachita Baptist University in fifth place with 311, Arkansas Tech's "B" team sixth with 313, Henderson State University seventh with 318, Southern Arkansas University eighth with 332, the Ouachita Baptist "B" team ninth with 343, and the University of Arkansas-Monticello tenth with 348.

Daniel Haughian of UCA led individual play with a two under par 70, Kevin Jones of DSU is a stroke back with a one under par 71, and Bryon Thom of ATU shot an even par 72. Nick Quast of ATU and Adam Frank of CMSU tied with one over 73's.

SAU individual scores were Chris Wasson with 79, Greg Griffin 82, Shep Morgan with 85, and Lance Lester with 86.

Match play continued through Tuesday.
