### **Golf Classic Completed**

Russellville, Ark. - The Arkansas Tech Collegiate Classic was completed Wednesday at Chamberlyne Country Club in Danville. When it was over, Delta State University was first with a 589 score, the University of Central Arkansas finished a stroke back with 590, and Central Missouri State University was a close third with 591.

Host Arkansas Tech University was fourth with 594, the Arkansas Tech "B" Team was fifth with 606, Henderson State University sixth with 625, Ouachita Baptist University seventh with 627, Southern Arkansas University eighth with 656, the Ouachita "B" Team ninth with 669, and the University of Arkansas-Monticello tenth with 677.

In individual play, UCA's Daniel Haughian was first with 142, DSU's Pier-Andre Roy and Clark Richardson, and Adam Frank of CMSU tied for second with 145, and Bryon Thom of ATU was fifth with 146.

For SAU, Chris Wasson finished with a two-day total of 160 and tied for 29<sup>th</sup> place. Greg Griffin shot 164 for a tie for 39<sup>th</sup>, Lance Lester was 44<sup>th</sup> with 167, Robert Lacy tied for 48<sup>th</sup> with 173, and Shep Morgan was 50<sup>th</sup> with 174.

The next golf action for the Muleriders is March 28-29 at Cypress Creek Country Club in Cabot, hosted by Central Arkansas.
