ATU First, Southern Arkansas Ninth in Golf

Cabot, Ark. - Arkansas Tech University was in the lead after two rounds of the University of Central Arkansas Intercollegiate Tournament played Monday at the Cypress Creek Course at Greystone Country Club.

ATU shot a 598 to lead by four strokes over Delta State University's 624. The Techsters held a seven-stroke lead over host University of Central Arkansas' 605.

University of Colorado-Colorado Springs was fourth with 624, Ouachita Baptist University fifth with 634, Arkansas Tech "B" Team sixth with 641, Henderson State University and Harding University tied for seventh with 654, Southern Arkansas University was ninth with a 657, the Ouachita Baptist "B" Team tenth with 663, University of Arkansas-Monticello 11th with 666, Christian Brothers University 12th with 677, Hendrix College 13th with 746, and Lyon College 14th with 753.

ATU's Nick Quast shot 72-73 (145) to take the first day individual lead. UCA's Kobus Erasmus, 74-72 (146) and ATU's Brent Wilson, 71-75 (146) tied for second a stroke back, and ATU's Byron Thom was another shot back, 73-74 (147).

Southern Arkansas was represented by Chris Wasson, 81-79 (160), Robert Lacy, 82-79 (161), Greg Griffin, 85-84 (169), Lance Lester, 84-86 (170), and Shep Morgan, 92-83 (175).

Tourney play continued through Tuesday.
