Delta State Surges Past Arkansas Tech in Golf

Cabot, Ark. - Delta State University surged past Arkansas Tech University to win the 2005 University of Central Arkansas Intercollegiate Tournament held Monday and Tuesday at Greystone Country Club. DSU was first with a team-leading 893 after three rounds with ATU second with 901. Tech led after two rounds Monday. Host UCA was third with 911.

The University of Colorado-Colorado Springs was fourth with 942, Ouachita Baptist University fifth with 959, the Arkansas Tech "B" Team sixth with 969, Henderson State University seventh with 977, Harding eighth with 983, the Ouachita "B" Team and the University of Arkansas-Monticello tied for ninth with 996, Southern Arkansas University fell to 11th with 1,002, Christian Brothers University was 12th with 1,003, Hendrix College 13th with 1,099, and Lyon College 14th with 1,118.

In individual play, Nick Quast of ATU was first with a three-round 217, and Pier Roy of DSU was second with 219.

SAU individual scores were Robert Lacy 246, Chris Wasson 251, Lance Lester, 254, Shep Morgan 260, and Greg Griffin 261.
