### **Muleriders Compete in Derrell Foreman Invitational**

Cleveland, Miss. - Southern Arkansas University was one of 19 teams competing in the Derrell Foreman Invitational golf tournament in Cleveland, Miss., Friday, hosted by Delta State University.

At the end of round one, Lindenwood University (Mo.) and the North Alabama Junior Varsity, were tied for first with a team-lead of 296, host Delta State was third with 303, Union University (Tenn.) was fourth with 305, the Lindenwood B Team, Arkansas Tech, Ouachita Baptist, and Harding University tied for fifth with 307, the University of Montevallo, University of Mobile, and Lewis University (Ill.) tied for ninth with 310, Henderson State was 12th with 311, Millsaps College was 13th with 314, the Arkansas Tech and Delta State B Teams tied for 14th with 315, William Carey College (Miss.) was 16th with 317, Mississippi College was 17th with 339, Southern Arkansas was 18th with 340, and Arkansas-Monticello 19th with 367.

Among individuals, Brock Robillard of Lindenwood led the way with a 69, Scott Saunier of William Carey was second with 70, Austin Osburn of Harding, and Matt Drinkard of Mobile, tied for third with 71, and Josh Pope of North Alabama's JV was fifth with 72.

For Southern Arkansas,, none placed among the top 20 individual scorers. The Muleriders were led by Robert Lacy with an 83, Lance Lester shot an 84, Jack Crowley 85, and Greg Griffin, and Shep Morgan, recorded 88's.

The second, and final round, will be played Saturday.
