### **UNA Jayvee's Win Golf Tournament, SAU 17th**

Cleveland, Miss. - The Derrall Foreman Invitational Golf Tournament held Friday and Saturday was not won by a university varsity team, but by a junior varsity. The University of North Alabama JV's finished first in the tournament with a two-day score of 582 to win first place honors. Lindenwood University (Mo.), the first-day leader, was a close second only a stroke back with a 583. Host Delta State University was third with 594, Arkansas Tech University fourth with 602, and Lewis University (Ill.) was fifth with 603.

The Lindenwood "B" Team was sixth with 606, Henderson State University, Ouachita Baptist University, and the University of Mobile tied for sixth with 607, and Harding University rounded out the top 10 with a score of 611.

Union University (Tenn.) was 11th with 614, the University of Montevallo (Ala.) was 12th with 617, Millsaps College (Miss.) was 13th with 619, the Arkansas Tech B Team was 14th with 623, William Carey College (Miss.) 15th with 633, the Delta State B Team 16th with 640, Southern Arkansas University 17th with 654, Mississippi College 18th with 659, and the University of Arkansas-Monticello 19th with a 706 score.

Jack Crowley shot a two-round total of 162 (85-77) to lead the Muleriders, and finished 73<sup>rd</sup>. Greg Griffin (88-76) and Robert Lacy (83-81) tied for 75th with 164's, Lance Lester (84-81) tied for 80th with a 165, and Shep Morgan (88-80) tied for 85th with a 168.

This was the final match of the fall for SAU. The team is off until their spring schedule begins in March.
