Southern Arkansas Tied for Sixth after First Round

Danville, Ark. - After the first round of the Arkansas Tech Collegiate Golf Classic held at Chamberlyne Country Club in Danville Monday, Southern Arkansas is in contention in a surprisingly strong sixth place tie.

Host Arkansas Tech is first with a 296 score, Henderson State is second with 302, Central Arkansas third with 304, the Arkansas Tech "B" Team is fifth with 307, Southern Arkansas and Southwest Baptist (Mo.) are tied for sixth with 324, Ouachita Baptist is eighth with 331, and Pittsburg State (Kans.) is ninth with 332.

Scott Genoway of Arkansas Tech leads individual play with a 71, Allen Branson of Henderson State is second with 72, and Luke Calcaterra (ATU) is third with 73.

Greg Griffin fired a 77 to lead SAU, good for a 15th-place tie, teammate Josh Smith shot an 80, Lance Lester had an 83, Heath Grant shot an 84, and Zac Hogle finished with an 85.

Round two is scheduled to be completed today.
