### **Mulerider Golfers Compete in Texas**

Commerce, Texas - After two days and three rounds, the Pepsi Crawford-Wade Invitational was completed Tuesday at Tanglewood Resort in Pottsboro, Texas, with Central Oklahoma an easy winner. Southern Arkansas placed 13th in the match.

Central Oklahoma, with three golfers placing one-two-three, and another tied for fourth, finished with a score of 834. St. Mary's (Texas) was second with 866, McMurry (Texas) was third with 887, East Central (Okla.) fourth with 892, Dallas Baptist and West Texas A&M tied for fifth with 901, Henderson State was seventh with 902, Southeastern Oklahoma State was eighth with 911, host Texas A&M-Commerce was ninth with 911, Ft. Hays State (Kans.) and Lincoln (Mo.) tied for 10th with 929, Incarnate Word (Texas) was 12th with 931, and Southern Arkansas University 13th with 966.

Among individuals, Todd Dayton, Matt Ellis, and Chance Tatum of Central Oklahoma placed one-two-three with scores of 202, 209, and 212, respectively, and teammate Blake Bowman tied Rode McElreath of McMurry for fourth with 214. Southern Arkansas' Greg Griffin tied for 26th with 226, Josh Smith tied for 52nd with 235, Zac Hoglund was 64th with 254, Heath Grant was 65th with 260, and Lance Lester withdrew in the second round, sandwiched with scores of 88 in the first round and 74 in the third.

Southern Arkansas competes next Monday and Tuesday at Chamberlyne Country Club in Danville in a tournament hosted by Arkansas Tech University.
