### **SAU Runs at Harding**

Searcy, Ark. – The Southern Arkansas Mulerider and Lady Mulerider track teams participated in the Bison Invitational Saturday hosted by Harding in Searcy.

In the men's 100-meter dash, SAU's Jermaine Logan was first in 10.58 for an easy win. Logan also blistered the field in the 200, winning in a comfortable 21.64 time.

In the 800-meter run, Muleriders' Jonathan Delaney and Michael Wooten placed sixth and seventh, respectively, in times of 2:07.62, and 2:08.02. In the 1500-meter run, Morgan Collier was fourth in 4:28.25. In the 3000-meter run, Adrian Romanos was second in 9:00.99 behind unattached Aaron Batey's 8:53.58.

Elia Elias was first for SAU in the 400-meter hurdles in a time of 55.69. Shane McLelland was third in 56.41.

The Muleriders competed against host Harding, Central Arkansas, Hendrix College, Arkansas-Little Rock, and several unattached participants.

In the women's division, Chantel Scott of SAU was fifth in the 400-meter dash in 1:03.33. Amanda Byers was 11th, and Maria Kolarevic was 13th, in the 800-meter run in the respective times of 2:38.09 and 2:40.09. Gaby Mendoza was fifth in the 1500 in 5:05.21, and Kendall Mears sixth in 5:05.87. Lindsay Musielak was sixth in the 3,000 in 11:25.19.

SAU's next meet is scheduled for Thursday and Friday at the Dogwood Invitational in Nacogdoches, Texas, hosted by Stephen F. Austin State.
