### **Lady Mulerider Summer Basketball Camps Scheduled**

Magnolia, Ark. - Southern Arkansas University Lady Mulerider head basketball coach Sam Biley announced Tuesday that the second annual Lady 'Riders Rookie Day Camp will be held June 28 through June 30 in the W.T. Watson Athletic Center. Girls entering the third through the sixth grades will receive instruction in ball handling, lay-ups, free throws, passing, and receiving on offense. Work on defense will include on-and-off the ball footwork and stance. The camp cost is \$65 per camper with a \$25 deposit. Camp hours are from 9 a.m. until noon.

Southern Arkansas will host its 34<sup>th</sup> annual Girl's Basketball Camp July 11<sup>th</sup> through July 15<sup>th</sup>. Girls entering the sixth through the 12<sup>th</sup> grades and meeting eligibility requirements set by the Arkansas Activities Association are eligible. Instruction, activities, and supervision will be classified according to age.

The camp will provide individual instruction in fundamental phases of basketball, including defense, rebounding, shooting, ball handling, and passing. There will be scrimmage games in the evening and at night with each camper participating in both. The camp staff will supervise all camp activities and functions, including all activities in the residence halls.

Camp coaches include Cecily Butler of Genoa Central, Lucy Williams of Crossett, Lynn Benson of El Dorado, Laura Kidd of Spring Hill, and Southern Arkansas assistant Ashley White. Lady 'Rider players will also assist and serve as counselors. Campers will be able to participate in other forms of recreation, such as swimming in the supervised campus pool and playing tennis.
